*Application Procedures for
Cuernavaca Summer Study Abroad Program – 2008*

For information on the program, attend the following meetings:

- The Study Abroad Fair on September 26th, 2007 in the Palo Duro Lounge, University Center from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. or The Study Abroad Fair scheduled for February 2008.
 - The *Cuernavaca Summer Study Abroad Informational Meeting* in late February, from 12:00-1:00 in Trimble Hall. (exact date TBA)
1. Download the *Cuernavaca Summer Study Abroad Application* form (.pdf format) at utacuernavaca2008.wordpress.com or at langlab.uta.edu. Applications are also available in the Department of Modern Languages Main Office, room 230, Hammond Hall.
 2. Fill out the application form and submit it in **paper form**, along with copies of transcripts, statement of purpose, and a Cashier's or Certified Check for \$100.00 made out to: Instituto de Lenguas y Estudios Latinoamericanos. All materials should be submitted to Dr. A. Raymond Elliott, who will forward them to the institute. **Deadline: March 31st, 2008.**
 3. Students will make arrangements for payment of UT-Arlington tuition.
 4. All students are required to attend an orientation meeting prior to departure. The orientation will be scheduled for April. Exact date, time and place will be announced at a later date.
 5. Students will be responsible for making their own travel arrangements. If students wish to travel with the program director, they may do so. He will make his travel information available to all those who wish to book travel on the same flight. Those traveling to Cuernavaca by themselves must arrive by July 5th, 2008.
 6. Students must also apply for a passport if they do not already have one. Applications are available online at the **U.S. Department of State** website.
 7. Please consult the **UT-Arlington's International Office Website** for further resources and information on studying abroad, including applications for International Student ID cards (if desired) and scholarships.
 8. We encourage students to apply for the Tony Litsey Memorial Scholarship, the International Education Fee Scholarship as well. Check with the Department of Modern Languages and the International Office for deadlines.
